

# Minutes of Gillingham Parish Council Meeting

## Extra Ordinary meeting

### 23<sup>rd</sup> August 2022

**Councillors Present:** Cllrs C. Hoare, A. Rymer, B. Warman, J. Ward, and S. Webber **Also Present:** Clerk.

- 1. Welcome: The Chairman welcomed everyone to the meeting.
- **2. Apologies:** Cllr Brown did not attend. There were 6 members of the public recorded.
- 3. Declaration of Interests other than those registered with South Norfolk Council: Cllr Warman noted that he lived in the same road as one of the planning applicants.
- 4. Parish Ten parishioners slot.
  - There appears to be more litter around Gillingham. Mr Bramley's management company has noted this and will add additional litter picks throughout the school and summer holidays.
  - There appears to be loads of lager cans in Old Yarmouth Road, opposite the Boundaries, Gillingham side up to the wood yard.
  - Garden rubbish at The Grove
  - The garden behind 30 The Street has large brambles etc and need to be cut down. This is Saffron. Action Clerk to investigate. Suggest that the Parish Council puts a note in the Tidings – 'It is the owners responsibility to cut back hedges/hedgerow and trees, which go on public property and could be a danger to vehicles and people.
- 5. To discuss and agree the issues with Barclays: The mandate has come back unsuccessful. A new mandate has been completed, signatures are needed again.
- 6. To discuss the Planning Applications received:
  - 2022/1447 Single Storey rear extension, Hornbeam Cottage, Loddon Road There are no public comments at the time of this meeting. Recommend Approval. Resolved.
  - 2022/1466 Erection of cart lodge (retrospective) 19 Kings Dam. The right of way footpath was discussed. This is no longer an issue as the map from SNC is out of date. Recommend Approval. Resolved.
  - BA/2022/0246/CLEUD Lawful Development Certificate for 10 years mooring use. Land at Gillingham
- This is a certificate of lawfulness and the Parish Council does not wish to comment. 7. Village/ Matters – to discuss and agree.
- Agree the quotes for the replacement glass on the bus shelter. The Parish Council has agreed to go with the toughened glass as agreed by the insurance company. Resolved.
- 8. Discuss the starting of the Neighbourhood Plan and the benefits. Ongoing
