### **Village Matters**

Notice received that The Street will be closed from Yarmouth Road Junction – 23-30th October. The churchyard at St Mary's Church has been cut with excess grass to be removed shortly. The parish council send their thanks to the Romanian Church for organising this.

The chairman said he had not been able to fix the bin to the shelter yet but was confident it should be in place next week.

Reports of overgrowing branches on the footpath leading to the foot bridge were received and this now appears to be getting worse. Councillor Hoare said he would see what he could do to clear it. Reports of flooding near the new bus shelter received – clerk has reported for investigation.

The clerk asked if the council should consider subscribing to Zoom for approximately £119 per year. The council discussed but decided to keep with the free service and revisit at a later date if it continued that they could not meet in person.

St Michael's school asked if they could lay a wreath for Remembrance Sunday at the war memorial. The council is still hoping to hold a service as usual if the new vicar can attend. Main service at Kirby Cane this year.
